MIDDLE SCHOOL HONOR CHOIR FESTIVAL ACCEPTANCE AGREEMENT

Directors are to bring this form, signed by the student and a parent, to festival registration.

- I hereby accept the place offered to me as a member of the AMIS International Honor Choir Festival.
I will thoroughly learn the festival music by working together with my teacher as well as on my own.
I understand that I will be audited by my teacher, two weeks prior to the festival, to ensure that my music is completely learned, and that I will not be permitted to participate unless I am thoroughly prepared. This could result in a loss of fees.
I understand that when housing festival participants with host families, it is often possible to place two or more students with the same family. I also understand that this is not always possible, as some families have space for only one guest. I accept that staying with host families in other parts of the world is an important part of the AMIS philosophy, and a major part of the festival experience in which I am to participate.
During the festival, I agree to abide by the following code of conduct. I understand that any infringement of the festival rules will be dealt with by the festival organizers and will be reported to my own school in order that any further disciplinary action deemed necessary by the administration can take place.
1. I will not use illegal drugs during the festival.
2. I will not drink alcohol during the festival.
3. I will attend all scheduled rehearsals, meetings, and the gala concert.
4. I will attend all group meals.
5. I will abide by the festival curfew.
6. I will not allow any situations wherein I am left unsupervised.
7. I will respond politely to requests made of me by the festival organizers, guest conductors, teachers, and host families.
8. I will treat my fellow musicians with respect at all times.
9. I will obey the laws of the host country.
I understand that images of students in rehearsal, performance, and festival social situations may be posted on the AMIS website and in AMIS publications, however individual students will not be identified.
